

Welcome to Olson Hereford Ranch and the 2022 All Breeds Cattle Tour!

We have been in the registered Hereford business since 1936, making us the oldest Hereford breeder in the state!. In 1991, we ventured into Red Angus — striving to produce Red Angus with more performance and growth. Currently, we run 200 females, including 50 Herefords, 140 Red Angus and 10 commercial recipient



cows. Additionally, we farm about 3,000 acres, raising corn, beans, wheat, oats and hay. We are located 7 miles west, 1 mile north and 1/2 mile west of Argusville. We are a family operation with Edward and Jeanne Olson working along with Carl, Lindsay, Dru and Stetson Olson.

Our annual Red Power Bull and Female Sale will be February 16, 2023, at the ranch. We will offer the top end of our bulls and 35 heifers. We have been consigning females to the North Dakota Red Select and North Star Classic Sales in the fall. We like to help new breeders get started and always have cattle for sale privately.

Performance is our priority, with an emphasis on udder quality, maternal traits and eye appeal. We use embryo transfer, artificial insemination, carcass ultrasound, pelvic measurements and DNA testing. We use rotational and cell grazing to maximize pasture productivity. We also raise all our own feed.

Our Red Angus herd traces to OHRR Dakota Copper 29K, who was a leader in the ABS lineup; and Red Global Trust 21T, sold with Cattle Visions and Pie Game Plan 0618, who is in top 1 percent of the breed for milk. Our current Red Angus herdsires are TWG Vessel U63D, DCND Direct Brilliance 971, Rreds Seneca E709 and Six Mile Encarnacion 866E.

Our Polled Hereford cows go back to VCR Kodiak 506E, Dakitch MDK Caretaker 51B and NJW Hometown 10Y. Some of our young sires are OHR Heppners Boss G6 and ANL 206E Bottom Line 39W 63H. Our newest sire is CMF 250D Holland 625H who is in the top 1 percent of the breed for weaning weight, yearling weight, maternal milk and growth, carcass weight, ribeye area and the Certified Hereford Beef index.





Many of the females sold at our sale are buybacks from customers who purchased Ressler Land and Cattle bulls.

From the AmericInn in Valley City, head west on Winter Show Road SW to 8th Avenue SW. Turn left on 8th Avenue SW and head south toward I-94. Head east on I-94 until Exit 307, Tower City. Head north toward Tower City over I-94. Turn right on ND-10 and travel east for 6 miles to Buffalo. At Buffalo, turn left and head 10 miles north on ND-38. Take a left on ND-4 and head east for 22 miles to 160th Avenue SE. Head north for 1 mile to 24th Street SE. Take right on 24th Street SE and travel for approximately 0.5 mile to the ranch.

ELLIOTT LIVESTOCK

From Olson Hereford Ranch, head west on 24th Street SE for approximately 0.5 mile to 16oth Avenue SE. Turn south on 16oth Avenue SE and travel for 1 mile to ND-4. Head west on ND-4 for 5 miles to ND-18. Turn right on ND-18 and travel for approximately 26 miles. Take a left on 4th Street SE and head west for 4 miles to 147th Avenue SE. 
