



Chief Brand Inspector Job Description

Key Qualifications:

1. Must have a peace officer's license or successfully complete the law enforcement course.
 2. Must be knowledgeable about the livestock industry and brand inspection.
 3. Must be willing to locate in the Bismarck, N.D., area.
 4. Must possess strong written and verbal communication skills.
5. The Employee agrees to perform all duties of the Chief Brand Inspector's office, including but not necessarily limited to the following:
- (a) Directly administer the brand recording and the brand inspection program for the State of North Dakota within the laws, regulations and guidelines prescribed by the State, the North Dakota Board of Animal Health and the North Dakota Stockmen's Association.
 - (b) Employ, train and maintain a competent staff of fieldmen and brand inspectors at markets and other inspection points.
 - (c) Supervise, direct and evaluate the work of all inspectors and fieldmen. (Note: local inspectors and their performance are to be supervised by fieldmen, but the final responsibility rests with the Chief Brand Inspector).
 - (d) Visit each market inspector at least twice each year to determine that inspection procedures and practices are being performed in a satisfactory and accountable manner.
 - (e) Maintain a close day-to-day-working relationship with the North Dakota Stockmen's Association Executive Vice President and consult with the Brand Board in all brand inspection matters, particularly those not covered by established policy, law or regulation.
 - (f) Keep, or cause to be kept, accurate and adequate office records of inspections while maintaining and administering the total brand inspection program.
