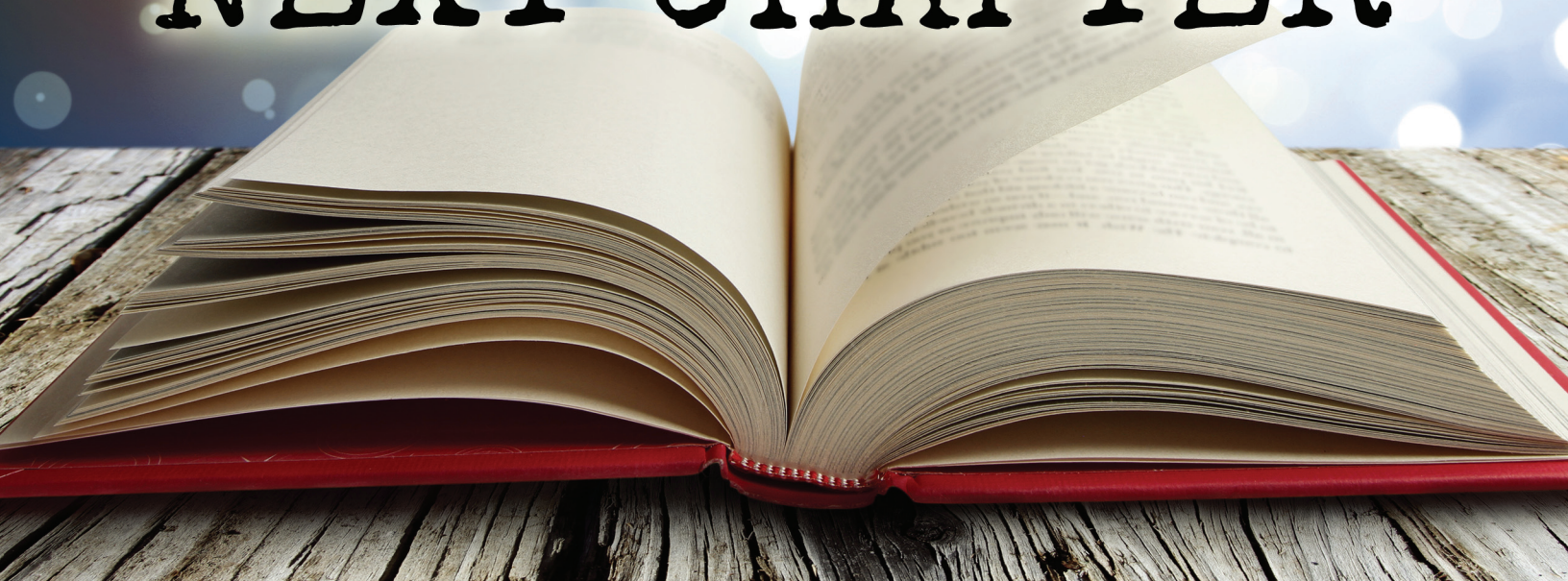
Even in its early years, the Foundation has made significant, page-turning contributions. With the support of generous donors, it has:
