Beef Industry Military Appreciation Day set for July 27 at State Fair

The North Dakota Beef Commission, the North Dakota Stockmen's Association and the North Dakota CattleWomen will salute active servicemen and servicewomen and their families at the North Dakota State Fair at the Beef Industry Military Appreciation Day. The free beef dinner will be held from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. CT (or until the food runs out) on Tuesday, July 27, in the Pioneer Village on the state Fairgrounds in Minot.

In addition to the free beef meal, the event will include children's activities, face painting, roping lessons and door prize drawings. The North Dakota State Fair is also offering reduced gate admission for military personnel (with military ID and coupon), and free carnival rides from 1 p.m. to 3 p.m. with a military ID.

This is the seventh year the beef industry has hosted the Military Appreciation Day picnic. More than 1,600 military and military family members were honored last year.
