*Contest Details

- -teams of two to four students
- -full briskets must be used, one per team, and are the responsibility of the team to obtain
- -each team will be reimbursed \$50 for brisket cost
- -cooking may be done at home and brought to Stanley or onsite Many will choose to cook at home, use care in transferring the product to Stanley.
- -teams are responsible for all their cooking supplies and heat sources
- -crock-pots are recommended to keep product warm during judging
- -all teams are required to be setup for judging by 5:00 pm the day of the contest
- -flats will be provided to give samples to the judges
- -see attached sheet that will be used to score the brisket

*Awards

- -each contestant will receive a kit from the North Dakota Beef Commission example of items in the kit include a temperature probe, cooking utensils, an apron, etc.
- -each contestant will receive a "powered by beef" t-shirt
- -Awards for top three teams and people's choice examples of awards include hooded sweatshirts, vest, etc. and of course bragging rights

*Other

- -a free meeting supper will be served at 6:00 pm and is open to all contestants, coaches, advisors, parents, etc.
- -it is asked that all contestants stay for the entire meeting
- -t-shirt sizes need to be provided by each contestant
